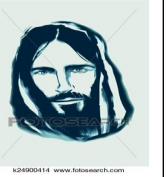

Commentary on Luke 4:21-30 Many achieve more among strangers than in their native place. They haven't to endure any family prejudice against them.

Locals often don't accept one of their own. God, however, is always searching especially for the one who will receive him. Elijah went out of his way to the widow in Sidon. Elisha cured no leper in Israel, but Naaman the Syrian. There needs to be some spiritual opening in a person for God to act in a miraculous way. The people of Nazareth wanted Jesus to perform miracles in his native place, but Jesus could see no indication that they were worthy to be given such a favour. The people in question here were jealous of their community of faith. Jesus was including all nationalities in the care and the saving love of God. They were jealous of their own relationship with God, and used it in many ordinary ways to keep others out of favour, off land and denied human rights to anyone outside their circle. Jesus is the one of universal welcome, his heart open in prayer and life to all, no matter their creed, nation, gender, age or any of the categories with which we are divided from each other.
